## Petitions ask election date be set for fire district vote

Pinal County supervisors have been asked to set an election date for a fire district embracing the boundaries of Arizona City.

A petition asking that a district be set up was presented to the supervisors following a conference with the county at-

torney. The petition carried the names of Arizona City property owners who are also residents qualified to vote.

J. Morris Mulkey, chairman of the Health and Safety committee of the Chamber of Commerce, said the proposed district would cover the four square

mile area within Arizona City.

He said the county attorney advised that when the district is set up and a fire department established, the boundaries could be extended to include adjacent areas if there is a demand from farmers and outlying property owners for such protection.

Arizona statutes provide that fire districts may be set up within a given boundary following approval of qualified real property taxpayers in the area to be served. The district can then organize a fire department and buy equipment with the limited tax funds received on the

basis of valuation of homes and business buildings within the area.

Mulkey outlined the fire district plan at the regular monthly meeting of the Chamber of Commerce February 7.

He particularly commended the members of his committee who he said had met every week for the past two months and had put hours of thoughtful effort into the project. Those working with him are Dale Newberry, William Lewallen, Francis Koehler, George Derdoski, Frank Hall and William Rutt.
