

Arizona City fire district election to be April 30

April 30 is the date for the special election to determine whether a volunteer fire company shall be organized within the boundaries of Arizona City. The area includes four square miles.

The election will be held at the country club and ballots may be cast from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Only qualified electors who are also property owners within the proposed district, who have registered for the special election, will be eligible to vote. Registration was carried on by Arizona City deputy registrar, Mrs. Mayme Otellio, from March 30 to April 20. Election officials will be Mrs. Irene Koehler, Mrs. Viola Newberry and Frank Hall. The fire district election is the culmination of months of work by a committee appointed by the Chamber of Commerce. Assisting committee chairman J. Morris Mulkey has been Dale Newberry, William Lewallen, Francis Koehler, George Deroski, Frank Hall and William Rutt.
