## Fire alarm system now has emergency phone

Installation of a "hot line" for the Arizona City fire alarm system, augmenting the emergency fire line, was announced this week by Francis "Boots" Brown, chief of the volunteer fire department.

Brown said the alarm system now includes a telephone at the fire station in the Community Center building, with extensions which will ring in his home and in the home of William Lewallen, department secretary.

"This is a hot line for emergency only and in no event is it to be used for private calls," Brown warned. "We are advising all residents to post the

emergency number 466-3595 near their telephone."

The fire chief said the department has purchased a resuscitator for use in first aid and life saving emergencies.
